

Project Categories for Capital Funding Requests/ CEF Grant and Loan Programs

The District Mission Board and/or the World Mission Board must actively participate in the development and implementation of the outreach ministry plans to be eligible for grants or loans involved in each of the following project categories:

Mission Establishment Phase	This is a fully funded effort by the BHM or by the BHM along with funds from a self-supporting congregation for a specified period. The exploratory work has been done and approval has been granted for 2-3 years for the mission to establish itself.	Unless the BHM EC would grant special approval, mission churches are not typically encouraged to purchase land or construct a worship facility during the establishment phase.	May apply for CEF loan at lending rate for parsonage acquisition.
Mission Development Phase	This is a fully funded effort by the BHM to develop a mission congregation which has gone through the 2-3-year establishment phase. They are moving toward the goal of financial self-support status within five to seven years. Mission Enhancement Phase	<p>This phase includes:</p> <p>a) A mission congregation blessed with growth calls a second staff person. The congregation receives declining subsidy for up to 3 years to help fund the 2nd worker.</p> <p>b) A self-supporting congregation receives BHM approval returning to Mission Development Phase.</p>	Based on the understanding that the congregation has already received land and worship facility grants, the congregation is not eligible for a CEF matching grant.	May apply for CEF loan at lending rate

Mission Relocation	A congregation still under the supervision of the DMB / BHM requests and receives approval to relocate their center of operations. Mission Expansion Phase	A mission congregation has grown and needs to expand. Working with the OMB, approval is given to move forward with expansion.	N/A	May apply for CEF loan at lending rate.
Congregation with a WEF Unit	A mission or self-supporting congregation that operates out of a WEF unit and has not previously received a full matching grant allocation for expansion. (Expires April 2021)	Eligible for the 2 to 1 CEF matching grant on down payments of 10% for facility expansion (capped on up to 5,000 sq. ft.)	May apply for CEF loan at lending rate.
Mission-minded, Self-supporting Congregation	A congregation not under the direction of the BHM but has a mission mindset and seeks to expand its operations (i.e. school, expansion, merger, etc.)	N/A	May apply for CEF loan(s) at lending rate (funds availability criteria apply).
Campus Ministry	Ministry that is serving the needs of students on or at a college campus and seeks to expand with land and facilities.	<p>Eligible for matching grants – Campus Ministry:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 4 to 1 CEF land grant ▪ 2 to 1 CEF facility grant ▪ Matching grants based on 10% down payment ▪ Maximum eligibility: 5 acres of land, 5,000 sq. ft. of facility ▪ Existing facility purchase – grants determined by CEF MAI appraisal assigned values to land & facility. ▪ Separation of CEF Land and Facility grants for existing property purchase is allowable as follows: Land grants at time of purchase, facility improvement loan / grant request within 24 months of purchase date. ▪ Purchase down payment funds attributable to existing facility not used / matched for grant purposes is eligible for facility improvement grant match. Schools Owned and/or Operated by an Association	An area high school or elementary school supported and operated by an association of WELS congregations with the approval of the DMB/BHM.	N/A	May apply for CEF loan(s) at lending rate (funds availability criteria apply).
World Missions	Facilities operated by the Board for World Missions to serve ministries abroad.	N/A	May request funding through the BWM, who in turn may apply for a CEF loan at rate determined by CEF
WELS Owned or Affiliated Facilities	Facilities owned and/or operated by a WELS-affiliated organization.	N/A	May apply for CEF loan(s) at lending rate (funds availability criteria apply).
