WHAT DOES WELS CHURCH EXTENSION FUND DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information **WELS Church Extension Fund ("WELS CEF")** collects and shares depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security Number
- Bank or Credit Union Account Number

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons WELS CEF chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.
